MURRAY, Ky. - Murray State went 2-1 last week in its own Racer Classic after having its last two games of the weekend canceled. The Racers picked shutout Rhode Island, 2-0, and rallied to top Oakland in extra innings 7-6 Friday, but fell to Illinois-Chicago in a tough one, 2-1. Lexi Jones led Murray State on the weekend with a .444 average including her team-high fifth home run of the season. In the circle, Olivia Suski went six innings against Rhode Island, allowing just three hits with a career-best seven strikeouts in the combined shutout. Amber Van Duyse appeared in all three game on the weekend and gave up no earned runs on three hits with one strikeout.

THIS WEEKEND'S OPPONENTS:

vs. Northern Colorado Bears Mar. 16, 2018 9 a.m. Arrocha Ballpark

SERIES HISTORY: Friday will be the first ever meeting between the Racers and the Bears.


SCOUTING THE BEARS: Northern Colorado went 4-2 last week at Utah State's Aggie Invitational and are now 15-14 on the season. The Bears currently bat .236 as a team and are led at the plate by Lauren Paige and Jordyn Wiatrak at .319 and .308, respectively. Wiatrak currently leads UNC in RBIs at 18, while Paige has a team-high four doubles and is tied with Wiatrak in home runs at three. In the circle, Valerie Vidal leads the Bear pitching staff with a 1.75 ERA and a 10-5 record. As a unit, the staff has a 2.77 ERA and limits opponents to a .236 average.

SCOUTING THE JAYHAWKS: Kansas is off to a hot start this season and will enter their home tournament with an impressive 17-5 record. One of the top 50 offenses in the country, the Jayhawks are currently batting .308 and are led by the duo of Harli Ridling and Jessie Roan who have averages of .414 and .412, respectively. While Tarin Travieso leads the KU pitchers with a 1.64 ERA, Andie Formby has been their No. 1 with a 2.79 ERA and a 7-2 record. As a team, the Jayhawks have a 2.83 ERA.

Jasmine Laura is batting .328 to lead a Leatherneck offense that bats .256 as a team, while Hailey Duwa is hitting .323. Megan Lotarski leads WIU in the circle with a 3.29 ERA, 3-5 record and a .292 opponent's average. As a team, Western Illinois gives up 4.25 earned runs per game and allows opponents to hit .308 against them.

Both you and your team had a good weekend last week. Five weeks into the season, do you feel like it's beginning to click a little more for you guys as a team?

Definitely, as a team we have been grinding through the first half of the season and putting in the work every week to challenge and push each other. I think this past weekend was a great reflection of what our team has been moving towards in terms of being gritty and playing for each other.

You were used primarily as a reliever this past weekend. What is the main difference, in softball where true relievers are not common, between starting a game and coming in once it has started?

In my opinion, being a reliever in softball is about being all in for your teammates. Starting a game is a little bit different in that the scoreboard reads "0-0", however as relief, it is completely normal to go in when bases are loaded or during other high pressure situations. It is in those moments that playing for the people to your left and right truly resonates, because the odds are generally against you and it is easy to let negativity creep in. But when I look at my teammates during those high pressure situations, I know they have my back and in those moments I am going to do everything in my power to have theirs.

This is the largest pitching staff the team has had since you arrived. Does that put more pressure on you to perform now there are other people waiting for a chance or does it take pressure off knowing that there are people behind you that have your back?

I think that it is a really cool and unique opportunity to have five completely different pitchers to utilize on our staff. We all bring something different to the table and the support within our staff is absolutely incredible. It is a really awesome experience to be able to push one another while knowing that we all have the utmost confidence in one another to perform when we are called on.

What was the primary reason you chose to make Murray State your home away from home three years ago?

At the end of the day I chose Murray State to be my home because family is something that I value. Not only does the Murray State softball team exemplify a family, but the community as a whole is a model of the type of place and people that I want to surround myself with.

WEATHER FORECAST

Temps on Friday in Lawrence will be in the low 70s, while the rest of the weekend will hover around the low 60s. Chance for rain are high on Friday at 61-percent and extremely high on Sunday at 86-percent. On Tuesday, in St. Louis, temps will be in the mid 40s with a 25-percent chance of rain.

ALONE AT THE TOP

With her triple against Oakland, Brenna Finck took over sole possession of first in Murray State's all-time triples category with nine. The junior also owns the single-season mark for triples that she set last season with six.

SETTING THE STANDARD

Both Olivia Suski and Haven Campbell struck out seven batters against Rhode Island and UIC, respectively, last weekend. The seven strikeouts is a new season high for a Racers pitcher and a career-best for Suski.

GOOSE EGG

Murray State shutout Rhode Island, 2-0, last week marking the second shutout of the season for the Racers. It was the first combined shutout for Suski, while it was the third for Van Duyse. The game also went down as the third save of Van Duyse's career and second this season.

OK, WHAT'S NEXT?

Next weekend the Racers will head east for their first weekend of conference play. On Saturday, MSU will begin its biannual trip to the other end of the Commonwealth with Eastern Kentucky, followed by Morehead State on Sunday.

PREVIOUS NOTES

WELCOME HOME!

The Racers are 4-5 all-time in home openers and are 3-3 under head coach Kara Amundson. After beating Rhode Island earlier this year, MSU has now won three home openers in a row.

LET'S DO IT AGAIN!

This season marks the second year for the Racer Classic, this time with six total teams. MSU ran the table at last year's event, going a perfect 5-0.

BRING THE BATS, GET THE WIN

Murray State has outhit its opponent five times this season and the Racers are now 5-0 in those games. However, when they are outhit by their opponents, MSU is just 1-12 on the year.

MOVE 'EM AROUND

Sierra Gilmore, Brenna Finck and Jensen Striegel have all been highly successful at advancing runners around the bases this season. Gilmore currently leads the way at 21-for-32 (65.6), while Finck and Striegel follow at 18-for-28 (64.3) and 13-for-21 (61.9), respectively.

BY LAND OR BY AIR

Haven Campbell and Olivia Suski have almost retired the exact same number of batters this season, however they have each done it differently. Campbell has gotten her opponents to ground out 71 times and fly out 38, while Suski has gotten opposing batters to fly out 56 times and ground out 52.

MIXED MEDIA

All 10 games on Friday and Saturday, including three for Murray State, of this weekend's Racer Classic will be video streamed live, free-of-charge on OVCDigitalNetwork.com (weather permitting). On Sunday, both MSU games will be audio streamed, also free-of-charge, on Mixlr.com/MSURacers.

RECORDS WERE MEANT TO BE BROKEN

The 21 runs scored against Tennessee Tech by Murray State broke the previous MSU single-game record for runs of 19 which was set against Tennessee State in 2011. The Racers also set a new RBI mark in the game with 17, besting the previous record of 16 set in the same game against TSU.

WIN WHEN IT COUNTS

Friday's extra inning win over UAB marked the 21st time that the Racers had gone to extra innings under head coach Kara Amundson. Murray State is now 13-8 in extras in the Amundson era and has won each of its last three games of eight innings or more.

TWO IS THE MAGIC NUMBER

Murray State scored two runs in each of its three losses last weekend to move to 0-6 on the year when scoring 0-2 runs. Conversely, the Racers are 3-0 on the year when they can hold their opponents to two runs or less.

MORE IS BETTER

The Racers have outhit their opponents four times this season and have won all four of those contests. However, when MSU is outhit on the year, it is just 1-8.

MOVIN' ON UP

Senior Haven Campbell needs just five strikeouts to move into the top five all-time in MSU history in strikeouts. She currently has 131 for her career and needs 136 to tie Kristen Broadway, who played from 2010-2011.

EXTRA SALAMI

With her second grand slam of the year, Lexi Jones became just the fourth Murray State player in program history to hit two grand slams in the same season Friday against Drake. She joins Jenna Bradley and Lauren Buch, who did so in 2011, and Leslie Bridges, who accomplished the feat in 2012.

SAVING GRACE

Junior Grace Vaughn recorded a save against Drake Friday, making her just the 10th pitcher in program history.

OUT OF THE GOETZ

Junior Lillie Goetz got her Murray State career off to a hot start as she began the season with a six-game reached base streak.

WELCOME TO THE CLUB

Lexi Jones became just the 12th player in school history to hit a grand slam when she did so in the first inning Friday against ETSU. Jones would not get another hit in the game, but did drive in one more run to finish with a career-high five RBIs.

A DOUBLE TRIPLE

Brenna Finck belted out three doubles in the season-opener against ETSU, tying the school record. Finck now joins Casey Castile from 2013 and Maggie Glass from 2016 as Racers who have accomplished the rare feat.

FINDING A WAY

Lillie Goetz tallied hits in three of MSU's four games last weekend, but reached base in all four. Goetz is currently hitting .400 on the year, but her on-base percentage is higher thanks to three walks at .571.

POWER SUPPLY

Madison Culver is currently slugging 1.000 on the year thanks to a single, a triple, and two home runs last weekend. Culver finished her first weekend at the plate by going 4-for-12.

THE INSIDE TRACK

FILLING THE GAP

The Racer class of 2017 left a large hole to fill for 2018 when it came to offensive production. However, the Racer newcomers answered the call on opening weekend with Sierra Gilmore, Dani Walls, Lillie Goetz and Jensen Striegel combined for over half of MSU's in the four-game stretch with 17 of 30 hits. Gilmore led MSU on the weekend by going 6-for-12 for a .500 average.

JUST PEACHY

For the fourth year in a row, the Racers will kick off their season in the state of Georgia. In 2015, the Racers went 3-2 at Georgia's Red & Black Classic in Athens, in 2016, they went 2-2 at the Kennesaw State Kickoff Classic in Kennesaw and last year went 4-1 at the Mercer Invitational in Macon.

OUT OF THE GATES

Murray State is 5-4 all-time in season openers, having won five out of seven under head coach Kara Amundson. The Racers are 1-1 in season openers in true away games and 4-3 in neutral site games.

FALL REPORT

Murray State went 8-0 in its non-traditional fall season this year with wins over Evansville, SIU and Saint Louis. As a team, the Racers hit .322, while the pitching staff posted a 1.75 team ERA and limited opponents to a .187 average. Freshman Sierra Gilmore led MSU with a .583 average, while junior Brenna Finck batted .400. Senior Haven Campbell went 4-0 in the short season, while freshman Olivia Suski went 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA.

A NEW ERA

Of its 10 starters from a year ago, only two return for Murray State in 2018. The seven offensive players lost represents 57.7 percent of MSU's hitting from a season ago, 65.2-percent of its scoring, 72.6-percent of its run production and 77.0-percent of its power hitting.

A FAMILIAR FACE

After spending four years as a player for Murray State, two-time OVC Player of the Year Jessica Twaddle returns to the Racers this season in a different role. Twaddle will serve as a volunteer for MSU while pursuing her Master's.
