

STARKVILLE, Miss. - Murray State went 2-2 last weekend in Starkville with wins over Drake and South Alabama, who received votes in last week's NFCA poll, but fell to host Mississippi State and in a rematch with South Alabama. Haven Campbell went 2-0 on the weekend with six strikeouts, compared to just three walks, while limiting opponents to a .218 average. Madison Culver led Murray State on the weekend with a .385 clip, while Lexi Jones belted her second grand slam of the season and a team-high third home run of the season.

**SERIES HISTORY:** The Racers will face a familiar foe Friday when they take on Tennessee Tech for the 22nd time overall and first time outside of OVC regular-season or tournament play. MSU won the last game between the two teams last season, putting an end to a four-game win-streak by Tennessee Tech. The Racers are just 1-2 against TTU all-time at neutral sites, but do hold a 12-9 advantage in the overall series.

**SCOUTING THE GOLDEN EAGLES:** The Golden Eagles finally found the win column last weekend by beating Western Kentucky twice and will enter this weekend at 2-7 overall. Bayli Cruse has been outstanding for tech this season, going 11-for-30 with a team-high 10 RBIs. Raegan Sparks currently leads the Golden Eagles with a .400 average, while as a team, Tech is batting .363. The Tech pitchers currently have a combined ERA of 9.65 and allow opponents to .322 against them. Taylor Waldrop currently sports the staff's best ERA, at 5.93, and is 1-2 on the season with a team-high 24 strikeouts.

**SCOUTING THE TROJANS:** Troy is off to a 5-3 start to the year, after going 2-2 at last week's Hillenbrand Innovational at Arizona. Katie Webb and Logan Calhoun are currently leading a Troy offense that is hitting .249 as a team, by batting .393 and .391, respectively. Opponents are currently hitting .227 against the Trojans, while their pitching staff currently has a 1.65 ERA. Peyton Glover has been the ace of the Trojan staff so far this season with a 2-0 record in five appearances and 1.14 ERA, 21 strikeouts and a .222 opponent's average.

**SERIES HISTORY:** The Racers are just 1-4 all-time against the Blazers with the last win coming as part of a doubleheader in Birmingham in 2011. The two teams met last season at UAB as part of the Samford/UAB Classic with the Blazers picking up another win in the series at 4-0. This weekend's meeting will be a first for the series marking the first time the two teams have not met on the Blazers' home field.

**SCOUTING THE BLAZERS:** The Blazers have gone 3-7 in the first two weeks of the Amanda Ellis era including a 2-3 performances at last weekend's Mary Nutter Classic in Cathedral City, California. As a team, UAB is currently hitting .257, while opposing teams have hit .332 against them. In the circle, the Blazer pitchers have combined for a staff ERA of 4.52 with 44 strikeouts and 32 walks. Emily Kachel has been the go-to pitcher for UAB this season and is currently 3-3 with a 2.67 ERA, 25 strikeouts, eight walks and opponents have hit .274 against her. Offensively, Destini England leads the way at .382, while Madison Millsaps and Analyse Petree follow closely at .355 and .346.

#### **WEATHER FORECAST**

#### **EXTRA SALAMI**

With her second grand slam of the year, Lexi Jones became just the fourth Murray State player in program history to hit two grand slams in the same season Friday against Drake. She joins Jenna Bradley and Lauren Buch, who did so in 2011, and Leslie Bridges, who accomplished the feat in 2012.

#### **SAVING GRACE**

Junior Grace Vaughn recorded a save against Drake Friday, making her just the 10th pitcher in program history.

#### **OUT OF THE GOETZ**

Junior Lillie Goetz got her Murray State career off to a hot start as she began the season with a six-game reached base streak.

#### **OK, WHAT'S NEXT?**

The Racers will make the short trip to Carbondale next weekend for the annual Coach B Classic where they will take on Illinois, Northern Illinois and the host Salukis.

### **PREVIOUS NOTES**

#### **WELCOME TO THE CLUB**

Lexi Jones became just the 12th player in school history to hit a grand slam when she did so in the first inning Friday against ETSU. Jones would not get another hit in the game, but did drive in one more run to finish with a career-high five RBIs.

#### A DOUBLE TRIPLE

Brenna Finck belted out three doubles in the season-opener against ETSU, tying the school record. Finck now joins Casey Castile from 2013 and Maggie Glass from 2016 as Racers who have accomplished the rare feat.

#### **FINDING A WAY**

Lillie Goetz tallied hits in three of MSU's four games last weekend, but reached base in all four. Goetz is currently hitting .400 on the year, but her on-base percentage is higher thanks to three walks at .571.

#### **POWER SUPPLY**

Madison Culver is currently slugging 1.000 on the year thanks to a single, a triple, and two home runs last weekend. Culver finished her first weekend at the plate by going 4-for-12.

#### **FILLING THE GAP**

The Racer class of 2017 left a large hole to fill for 2018 when it came to offensive production. However, the Racer newcomers answered the call on opening weekend with Sierra Gilmore, Dani Walls, Lillie Goetz and Jensen Striegel combined for over half of MSU's in the four-game stretch with 17 of 30 hits. Gilmore led MSU on the weekend by going 6-for-12 for a .500 average.

#### JUST PEACHY

For the fourth year in a row, the Racers will kick off their season in the state of Georgia. In 2015, the Racers went 3-2 at Georgia's Red & Black Classic in Athens, in 2016, they went 2-2 at the Kennesaw State Kickoff Classic in Kennesaw and last year went 4-1 at the Mercer Invitational in Macon.

#### **OUT OF THE GATES**

Murray State is 5-4 all-time in season openers, having won five out of seven under head coach Kara Amundson. The Racers are 1-1 in season openers in true away games and 4-3 in neutral site games.

#### **FALL REPORT**

Murray State went 8-0 in its non-traditional fall season this year with wins over Evansville, SIU and Saint Louis. As a team, the Racers hit .322, while the pitching staff posted a 1.75 team ERA and limited opponents to a .187 average. Freshman Sierra Gilmore led MSU with a .583 average, while junior Brenna Finck batted .400. Senior Haven Campbell went 4-0 in the short season, while freshman Olivia Suski went 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA.

#### A NEW ERA

Of its 10 starters from a year ago, only two return for Murray State in 2018. The seven offensive players lost represents 57.7 percent of MSU's hitting from a season ago, 65.2-percent of its scoring, 72.6-percent of its run production and 77.0-percent of its power hitting.

### A FAMILIAR FACE

After spending four years as a player for Murray State, two-time OVC Player of the Year Jessica Twaddle returns to the Racers this season in a different role. Twaddle will serve as a volunteer for MSU while pursuing her Master's.
