LAST TIME OUT

MURRAY, Ky. - Twelfth-ranked Jacksonville State ended the game with 21 unanswered points to top Murray State, 42-15, Saturday afternoon in Murray and put an end to its four-game win streak. Despite the loss, the Racers, now 4-1 in OVC play, are still one of three teams, along with the Gamecocks and Southeast Missouri, with one league loss that are still in the hunt for an OVC title. After an early score by JSU, Anthony Koclanakis ran back an interception for 37 yards to pull the Racers within one at 7-6. Late in the second quarter, Gabriel Vicente knocked down a 23-yard field goal with just seconds left in the first half to make the score 21-9 at the break. On the first play from scrimmage of the second half, Don Parker knocked the ball loose from JSU's Jaelen Greene allowing Marquez Sanford to recover the ball and giving MSU a first-and-10 at the JSU 48. Off the turnover, Drew Anderson took his team down the field and capped the drive with a 17-yard rush for a touchdown that pulled the Racers within six at 21-15. From that point on, however, JSU reeled off three touchdowns and shut the MSU offense down in the process for the 42-15 win.

SATURDAY'S OPPONENT:

vs. Tennessee Tech Golden Eagles **Nov. 3, 2018** **1:30 p.m.** **Tucker Stadium**

SERIES HISTORY: The Racers put an end to a three-game skid in the season series last season, when they topped the Golden Eagles, 31-21 in Murray, to narrow Tennessee Tech's lead in the series at 44-38-1. Murray State is 24-15 all-time in trips to Cookeville, where they have lost both of the last two meetings. The last win for the Racers at Tucker Stadium came in 2011, when Chris Hatcher's quad knocked off the then 15th-ranked Golden Eagles, 38-37.

SCOUTING THE GOLDEN EAGLES: Tennessee Tech enters Saturday at 0-8 and 0-5 in the OVC, after falling at Austin Peay last week, 41-10. The Golden Eagles currently average 19.0 points per game, while allowing 51.0 points per game. Of their 346.1 yards of total offense per game, 143.8 comes on the ground, while the other 202.4 comes in the air. On the other side of the ball, Tech allows 272.6 rushing yards per game and 290.0 passing yards per game for 562.6 total yards per game. Bailey Fisher is 111-for-220 on the year for 1,385 yards with nine touchdowns and six interceptions while Darius Stafford leads the Tennessee Tech receivers in yards at 269. On the ground, Andrew Goldsmith has 309 yards and a score, while defensively, Deontay Wilson has a team-high 75 tackles and Andrew Swicegood has a team-high 6.5 tackles for loss. On special teams, Nick Madonia continues to be one of the best kickers in the league as he is 11-for-17 on the season in field goals with a long of 54 and is 17-for-17 on PATs.

WEEK 10 NOTES - TTU

SATURDAY'S WEATHER

The high Saturday in Cookeville will be just 58, despite a fairly low chance of rain at eight-percent and low winds at 4-6 mph out of the SSQ.

LEADING THE WAY

With his 13 solo tackles against JSU, Quincy Williams now leads the FCS in solo tackles per game at 74. Williams currently leads MSU on the season with 82, including 59 solo.

WE CAN SCORE TOO

The Murray State defense is currently 5th in the nation in defensive TDs with three. Jason Johnson recovered a fumble in the end zone against UT Martin, while Quincy Williams and Anthony Koclanakis had interception returns for touchdowns against UTM and Jacksonville State, respectively.

NO RETURNS

The Racers are currently eighth in the nation in punt return defense at just 2.67 return yards per punt. In addition, thanks to their strong punt return defense and spot-on punting from Steve Dawson, MSU is ninth in net punting at 39.8 yard per punt.

OK, WHAT'S NEXT?

The Racers return home for the final time this season to take on Southeast Missouri State. The game has been selected by the OVC as one of their "wildcard" Game of the Week selections and will be broadcast on ESPN3. Kickoff is scheduled for 1 p.m. with Kevin Ingram and Bob Belvin on the call.

WEEK 9 NOTES - JSU

HOT STREAK

The Racers are 4-0 in OVC play for the first time since 1996 and have won each of their last four games. The four-game winning streak is the longest by the Racers since they won the last four games of the 2004 season.

WINNING IN RICHMOND

With his win Saturday, Mitch Stewart became the first MSU head coach to win back-to-back games at ECU since Don Shelton accomplished the feat in 1960 and 1962.

TOP FIVE RACERS

Currently, three Racers are in the top five nationally of three different statistical categories. Gabriel Vicente is currently one of five kickers that has not missed this season, to lead the nation in field goal percentage. In addition, Kenney Wooten is fourth in the nation in sacks per game at 1.14 per game, while Quincy Williams is third in the nation in solo tackles per game at 6.6.

WEEK 8 NOTES - ECU

MOVING ON UP

With seven solo tackles against TSU, Quincy Williams moved up to third in the nation with 6.7 per game in addition to leading the OVC.

WHO'S NOT HONORING HIM NOW

Drew Anderson threw for 348 yards and five touchdowns and rushed for another in route to one of the best weeks for a Murray State quarterback in recent memory. For his efforts, he was named as the OVC Offensive Player of the Week, OVC Newcomer of the Week, Ohio Valley College Madness Offensive Player of the Week and the STATS National Offensive Player of the Week. His STATS honor was the first for a Racer since 2015.

IMPROVING WHERE IT COUNTS

Off to their best start since 1997, a lot of the Racers success can be traced to their improvement on third-downs and in the red zone. On third down, MSU went from a 34.9 conversion percentage to 53.7 percent and in the red zone went from 50.0 percent to 85.8 percent.

SHORING UP THE LINE

After giving up at least 2.7 sacks per game, and as many as 3.4, in the last three seasons, the Racers have significantly paired that number down this season. Through the first, six games, MSU is allowing just 1.3 sacks per game, ranking them 29th in the FCS and second in the OVC.

CLAMPING DOWN

After allowing 14 points on 144 yards in the first quarter Saturday, the Racer defense clamped down and gave up just one touchdown and 226 yards over the final three quarters. The 21 points allowed in the game, is the fewest given up by the Racers this season.

RECEIVING BY COMMITTEE

Fourteen different Racers caught passes in Saturday with Corey Newble leading the way with 70 yards on six catches. By leading the Racers against TSU, Newble is now the fifth different Racer through six games to lead the MSU receiving efforts. In addition, Brooks was the only Racer receiver to have multiple touchdowns in the game, as he had two to go along with 25 yards on three receptions.

WEEK 7 NOTES - TSU

#STANDWITHCHRISTION

On September 29, TSU linebacker Christian Abercrombie suffered a severe head injury in the Tigers' game against Vanderbilt. As of Tuesday, Abercrombie began showing significant signs of improvement, but remains in critical condition. As a show of support, the Racers will wear a red number six, Abercrombie's number, trimmed in blue on the back of their helmets Saturday.

ALL BY MYSELF

Linebacker Quincy Williams currently leads the OVC and is seventh in the nation solo tackles per game at 6.6. In total, he averages 9.4 per game placing him 23rd in the FCS and fourth in the OVC.

RUNNING WITH THE RACERS

For a team known for its passing, the Racers put together one of the better rushing performances in team history against EIU and set a new modern-era single-game rushing record in the process. Murray State rushed for 449 yards in the game, besting the previous mark of 418 which came against this week's opponent, Tennessee State, in 2000.

HOT START

For just the third time since 1997, the Racers are 2-0 in the OVC. The only other previous time between 1997 and 2018 was in 2013.

ONE-TWO PUNCH

For the first time since 2006, the Racers had two 100-plus yard rushers Saturday with D.J. Penick rushing for 180 yards, while Rodney Castille added 142. The last time the feat occurred was in 2006 when Chad Cook rushed for 223 yards and Charlie Jordan rushed for 111 against Indiana State. The 180 yards on the ground by Penick was the most by a Racers since Mike Harris rushed for 206 against Eastern Kentucky in 2011.

THE INSIDE TRACK

VICTORY LAP

Murray State coaching legend Frank Beamer returns to The Track this week to celebrate his induction into College Football Hall of Fame. The legendary coach, who helmed the Racers from 1981-1986, followed by a highly successful stint at Virginia Tech from 1987 to 2015. Keeping the Murray State ties alive at Tech, former quarterback Justin Fuente was named as the new head coach of the Hokies following Beamer's retirement. Currently, Beamer is the only Murray State player or coach to be inducted into the College Football Hall of Fame.

WEEK 6 NOTES - EIU

FAMILIAR FACES

When staring across the field at an opponent's coaching staff, most people see the enemy however, the week Racer fans might see the face of some people they know. Head coach Kim Dameron served as the Racers' defensive coordinator from 1993-1995 under head coach Houston Nutt. Dameron's current defensive coordinator, Cary Fowler played on MSU's 1994 OVC Championship teams, under Dameron, and then served as a coach for the Racers for six seasons under Nutt, Denver Johnson and Joe Panunzio. In addition, outside receivers coach Tony Turner played on the 1995 and 1996 OVC title teams, playing for Dameron and with Fowler. Like Fowler, Turner also began his coaching career with the Racers.

BREAKING THE STREAK

The Racers win over UT Martin Saturday put an end to a streak of four straight losses in OVC openers. The last previous time MSU won in a league opener was in 2013, under then head coach Chris Hatcher, with a thrilling 35-34 overtime victory at Jacksonville State.

WIRE-TO-WIRE

Saturday also marked the first time since 2015 against Austin Peay that MSU had led an opponent in a game from start to finish.

STARTING STRONG

Murray State put up 323 total yards of offense in the first half, more than it had in any full game so far this season. In addition, the Racers' 31 points in the opening half was just two less than it scored in the first three games combined.

HONEY SMACKED

Junior Malik Honeycutt became the first Racer receiver this season to tally over 100 yards in a game when he popped the UT Martin defense for 137 yards on five catches. The transfer averaged 26.4 yards per reception with a long of 53 yards and is now fifth in the nation in yards per reception at 23.7.

DREW DOES IT BIG

Drew Anderson became the first Racer in over a year to throw for over 350 yards Saturday, as he went 21-for-32 for 397 yards with three touchdowns and just one interception. In addition, the fifth-year senior picked up a 17-yard rushing touchdown in the second quarter. Anderson's big numbers can almost certainly be traced back to his solid start to the game, as he went 14-for-14 to open with a game for a 179 yards and two touchdowns.

WINNER WINNER

Quincy Williams picked up MSU's first OVC weekly honor, when he was named as the Week Five Defensive Player of the Week. The senior led the Racers with 11 tackles including 2.0 for loss, a pass breakup and interception that he took 82 yards for a touchdown. The play extended MSU's lead to 21 points early in the fourth and would later prove to be the difference in the game, as MSU won by just one touchdown. Williams' pick-six was also the longest by a Racer since Lucas Holt went 88 yards against Tennessee Tech in 2004. The redshirt senior is now the first Racer to win the weekly defensive honor since Demetrius Mason in 2015.

WEEK 5 NOTES - UTM

A LONG-STANDING FEUD

UT Martin is currently Murray State's oldest active rivalry. The Skyhawks were the Racers' fourth ever opponent in MSU's inaugural season in 1924. Although, UT Martin, then known as Hall-Moody Institute, was Murray State's first three opponents, Union (TN), Lambuth, Evansville, either no longer sponsor football (UU, UE) or the school has closed all together (LU).

THE SECOND SEASON

Murray State is 29-41 all-time in OVC openers and is 16-19 when the opener takes place in Murray. The Racers and Skyhawks have met just once in an OVC opener, a 63-38 win by Martin in 2008 in Murray.

COACH TO CURE

Coach To Cure MD is a one-day, nationwide awareness building and fundraising event that will be held on September 29, 2018. The goal of Coach To Cure MD is to raise awareness of Duchenne muscular dystrophy (Duchenne, pronounced "DOO-SHIN"), generate new financial support for Duchenne research and to demonstrate coaches' commitment to the betterment of young men and the core academic research missions of their universities. College football coaches all over the country have been asked to wear a patch with the Coach To Cure MD insignia on Saturday, September 29th. By wearing this patch, coaches will show their support for Coach To Cure MD and the fight against this disease. On Saturday, Tristan Phelps, who lives with DMD, and his family will be the guests of the Racer and will conduct the opening coin toss.

SENIORS HONORED

Prior to Saturday's game 16 seniors will be honored with their loved ones as part of the annual senior night. This year's seniors are Drew Anderson, Shuler Bentley, Chase Boling, J.R. Burns, Xavier Chisolm, Rashad Johnson, Nolan Nichols, Silas Owens, Marquez Sanford, Tyler Stepney, Jordan Tyler, Chris White, Quincy Williams, Qmond Woods and Kenney Wooten.

WEEK 3 NOTES - UK

... AND HE CAN KICK TOO

After two years of handling the Racer kickoff duties, James Sappington made the switch to receiver this year and currently leads the team in all categories with 6 catches for 92 yards and one touchdown. He is also still the backup kicker and punter.

KENNEY'S BIG DAY OUT

Kenney Wooten did a little bit of everything Saturday at UCA as he had six tackles, four solo, 1.0 sacks, a blocked extra point and a pass breakup that led to an interception.

NO RETURNS

The MSU punt defense is currently one of the best in the nation at 27th, allowing just one return thus far this season for only two yards.

CREATING OPPORTUNITIES

Through two games, Murray State is 12th in the nation in turnovers gained with five, including two interceptions and three fumbles recovered.

WEEK 2 NOTES - UCA

SPREADING IT AROUND

The Racers completed 22 passes to 13 different receivers Thursday. Of those 13, eight caught multiple passes led by James Sappington's three.

BIG PLAY Q

Quincy Williams had several big plays in Thursday's opener and led all players in the game with nine tackles including seven solo. The senior also had 2.0 tackles-for-loss totaling 14 yards, a 10-yard sack and a forced fumble

HEALTHY RETURNS

DeQuan Dallas racked up 100 return yards on kickoffs Friday on five returns with a long of 24 yards for an average of 20 yards per return..

BIG DEBUTS

Koclanakis had four tackles, an interception and 10-yard return and a pass breakup in his MSU debut, while T.J. Warren and Kendrick Catis each had eight tackles in their first games in blue and gold. On special teams, Steve Dawson had five punts for 40.8 yards with a long of 50 in his first-ever football game.

WEEK 1 NOTES - SIU

WELCOME HOME

Thursday will be the 94th home opener for Murray State. The Racers are currently 64-26-4 all-time in those games.

Defensive lineman Kenney Wooten and kicker Gabriel Vicente started the season off on a high-note by being named to the 2018 Preseason All-OVC Team. Wooten led the OVC with 10.0 sacks and was ninth in the FCS last season, while Vicente was 14-for-18 on field goal attempts including the first 50-plus yarder for a Racer since 2002.
