MURRAY, Ky. - Last week was a tale of two completely different games, that sadly both ended in losses for the Racers. On Thursday, Murray State kept pace with three-time defending OVC champ Belmont and trailed by only three points with just 2:14 to play. However, despite not allowing a Bruin field goal over almost the final four minutes of the contest, the Racers could not finish and fell by seven. Evelyn Adebayo led the Racers with 20 points and 11 rebounds, while Janika Griffith-Wallace added 14 off the bench. Saturday, for Murray State, was nearly the exact opposite of Thursday's game with the Racers in control for nearly the whole night. However, the Tigers were able to claw their way back, take the lead with 1:35 to go and never relinquish it. Adebayo was once again solid for the Racers with 16 points, but this time added a career-best 18 rebounds. Macey Turley led Murray State in the game with 20 points, off of 6-of-15 shooting.

SERIES HISTORY: The Racers may lead the all-time series with Jacksonville State, 16-7, but the Gamecocks have controlled the series as of late winning five of the last six meetings. In Jacksonville, the Racers have lost just twice with both of the losses coming in the last three meetings.

SCOUTING REPORT: After a win over Eastern Kentucky and a loss to Morehead State last week, Jacksonville State is currently 9-10 on the year and 3-5 in league play. Scoring wise, a game with Jax State this season is a virtual pick 'em with the Gamecocks scoring 57.5 points per game and allowing 57.4. The Gamecocks currently shoot 34.2-percent from the floor, 23.3-percent from 3-point range and 61.2-percent from the free throw line. Destiney Elliott currently leads JSU in scoring at 10.9 points per game, while Rayven Pearson follows at 9.6. Pearson also currently leads the Gamecocks in rebounds by averaging a near double-double at 9.8 per game.

SERIES HISTORY: Murray State has not had much luck against Tennessee Tech over the years, winning just 18 of 81 all-time-meetings, but recent results have gone in the Racers' favor. MSU has won three of the last five meeting and four of the last seven, with two of those wins coming in Cookeville, where the Racers are just 5-27 all-time.

SCOUTING REPORT: Picked seventh in the preseason poll, the Golden Eagles have been the surprise of the league this season and will enter the weekend at 15-4 on the year and 7-1 in the OVC. Jordan Brock has been one of the keys to TTU's success this year as she currently averages 14.3 points per game and shoots 42.4-percent from the floor. Akia Harris follows Brock with 9.2 points per game, as well as a team-high 4.9 assists. As a team, Tennessee Tech averages 72.1 points per game one 41.2-percent shooting, while holding opponents to 37.3-percent shooting and 62.5 points per game.

MORE HARDWARE

For the third time this season, Evelyn Adebayo was named as the OVC Newcomer of the Week. Over two games, she averaged 18.5 points and 8.5 rebounds.

ROLE REVERSAL

The Lady Vols are currently ranked 48th out of 349 teams in Division I when it comes to getting to the free throw line. However, when they get there they have trouble, shooting just 67.1 percent and ranking 209th. Conversely, MSU is the 28th best free throw shooting team in the country at 75.7 percent, but they have trouble getting to the line, ranking 231st in attempts at just 17.3 per game

Evelyn Adebayo and Macey Turley swept the weekly OVC awards for the Racers Tuesday with Adebayo being named both Player and Newcomer and Turley earning the Freshman nod. Adebayo notched a double-double in both games last week to average 22.0 point and 13.0 rebounds, while Turley averaged 14.0 points and 5.0 assists.

LEADING THE WAY

Evelyn Adebayo has had the most points and rebounds, either by herself or shared, in every game for the Racers this season. Already with five double-doubles in eight games, the transfer is averaging 17.6 point and 10.8 rebounds per game.

WELCOME BACK

For the first time since her departure following the 2007-08 season, Jody Adams returns to the CFSB Center, this time as an assistant coach for SIU. Adams coached one season at the Bank, guiding the Racers to a 24-8 mark, an OVC tournament title and the program's first trip to the NCAA Tournament. Current Racer assistant Amber Guffey was a member Adams' championship squad.

GAME 8 NOTES - BET

A WIN THURSDAY WOULD...

Snap a three-game skid by the Racers which includes losses at Arkansas State and Illinois and at home against Alabama A&M.

FOUR & COUNTING

Evelyn Adebayo notched her fourth doubledouble of the season at Illinois with a careerhigh 23 points and 13 rebounds, which tied her previous career best.

BEST BEHAVIOR

The Racers continue to be one of the most disciplined teams in the nation as they have committed the sixth fewest fouls in the country. The Racers currently have 101 fouls on the season, while leader Montana has 94. at the CFSB Center in 2018.

GAME 7 NOTES - ILL

A WIN TUESDAY WOULD...

Give the Racers their first win over a Big Ten program. MSU is currently 0-4 against the power five league going with two losses against Indiana and one each against Purdue and Illinois.

DOIN' WORK

Through the first six games this season, Evelyn Adebayo has had three double-doubles. She is currently averaging 16.2 points and 10.0 rebounds per game placing her fourth and second in each category, respectively.

GAME 6 NOTES - AAMU

A WIN SATURDAY WOULD...

Give the Racers just their third 4-0 start at home since 2008-09. The only other previous time the Racer won their first four at The Bank was two seasons ago in 2016-17.

MOVIN' ON UP

With their 18-for-20 performance at the charity stripe Tuesday at Arkansas State, the Racers skyrocketed from 10th to 4th nationally in free throw percentage. MSU is currently shooting 82.2 percent from the free throw line, while DePaul leads the nation at 85.0.

DANGEROUS FROM DOWNTOWN

As a team, Murray State currently has the seventh best three-point shooting percentage in the nation at 41.8 and the nation's 12th-best hree-point shooter in Lex Mayes, who is making 55.2-percent of her three-point attempts. St. Francis Brooklyn currently paces the nation in team percentage at 44.4, while Shalexxus Aaron leads individually at 72.7 percent.

BEASTS UNDERNEATH

The Racers currently lead the OVC in both rebounds per game and rebound margin. MSU currently averages 43.0 boards per game, while outrebounding their opponents by an average of 9.6 rebounds per game. Those numbers currently place the Racers 47th nationally in rebounds per game and 27th in rebound margin.

Murray State currently ranks in the top 10 nationally in three separate categories. They are 10th in free throw percentage at 80.0, eighth in scoring offense at 89.0 and fifth in fewest fouls at 54.

EIGHT IS GREAT

In three of their four games this season, the Racers have limited their opponents to just eight points in the opening stanza. They did so against Evansville, Oakland City and Lipscomb and went 3-0 in those contests.

THE INSIDE TRACK

THREE FOR ALL

Macey Turley kept Murray State's streak of winning a weekly award alive Tuesday when she was named as the OVC Freshman of the Week for the second time this season.

A FRIENDLY FACE

Arkansas State assistant Todd Buchanan is no stranger to the Racers, as he is a 1995 graduate of Murray State. In addition to his time as a student at Murray State, Buchanan served as an assistant for the Racer women from 1992-1995 and also coached at three local high schools; Lyon County, Calloway County and Murray.

GAME 4 NOTES - LIP

A WIN TUESDAY WOULD...

Give the Racers their first three-game winstreak at home since 2016-17 when they posted wins over MacMurray, Tennessee State and Eastern Illinois (Dec. 12 -Jan. 11).

BACK-TO-BACK

Although she did came up just short of her third straight double-double against Butler, Evelyn Adebayo was named as the OVC Newcomer of the Week, giving the Racers a weekly winner in each of the first two weeks of the season. Macey Turley was the first winner for Murray State, taking home freshman honors last week.

TURNOVER TROUBLE

The Racers committed a season-high 23 turnovers against Butler, leading directly to 27 points for the Bulldogs. The game also marked the first-time this year that MSU had finished a game with more turnovers than assists (11).

GAME 3 NOTES - BUT

DOUBLE YOUR FUN

For the second time in as many games, Evely Adebayo notched a double-double. Through two games this season she is averaging 18.0 points per game and 11.5 rebounds.

BIG NUMBERS

The Racers scored 113 points against Oakland City Saturday for the fourth most points in school single-game history. In addition, the Racers' 40-made field goals is the 11th most in program history.

SPREADING THE LOVE

All 12 eligible players played for the Racers with 11 of them tallying points. Of the 11 players that scored in the game, seven reached double digits.

GAME 2 NOTES - OAK

OPENING STATEMENT

MSU's win Wednesday was the first in a season opener against a Division I team since beating the Purple Aces to start the 2011-12 season, as well as the largest margin of victory against any Division I opponents since a 32 point win over Alabama A&M in 2016-17.

HISTORIC DEBUT

With game-highs of 18 points and 10 rebounds, Evelyn Adebayo became the first known Racer to debut with a double-double (single-game records dating back to 1997-98) Wednesday versus Evansville.

QUICK TURNAROUND

In Wednesday's opener, the Racers addressed two areas of concerns from the exhibition Thursday night, three-point and free throw shooting. The Racers were just 1-for-13 (7.7%) from three and 19-for-35 (54.3%) in their lone exhibition. However, on Wednesday, MSU was 7-for-10 (70.0%) from the stripe and 10-for-20 (50.0%) from beyond the arc.

GAME 1 NOTES - UE

LIFTING THE LID

Murray State opens its 52nd season of women's basketball Wednesday and is 22-30 all-time in season openers and 26-23 in home openers. The Racers are 4-4 all-time against UE in season openers and 3-3 against the Purple Aces in home openers.

SHAKING THE DUST OFF

The Racers won their only exhibition of the year last Thursday, 72-51 over Lindsey Wilson. After sitting out last season due to NCAA transfer rules, Evelyn Adebayo easily got back in the groove and led MSU with 21 points, while Janika Griffith-Wallace posted a double-double with 13 points and 11 rebounds.

NEXT ONE UP

The Racers return just 20.4 percent of their scoring from last year with the most notable loss being the 2017-18 OVC Player of the Year, Ke'Shunnan James. Brianna Crane will lead all returners this season after averaging 7.2 points and 5.7 rebounds per game last season
